Commodore

Following my email to all members last week, I'm pleased to say that the situation has resolved (heatwave has passed and schools are back). Accordingly, I'm updating the security actions by dropping the request to lock the gate at the top of the lane - please try to push the gate closed (without locking).

Please see below the actions we would like you to take to improve security at the club:

1. We are dropping the request to lock the barrier (due to emergency access). We will reconsider this for summer holiday time. Please remember to lock when you are the last person leaving.
2. **No tailgating** – all legitimate users have a code
3. Outside of scheduled activities, **please keep clubhouse doors locked** – please lock balcony door and ensure door to car park side is closed on combination lock (the number is the member's barrier code)
4. If you see people that you don't recognise in the clubhouse or surrounding area, please ask if they are members
5. If you see groups of people on far side of lake please advise them politely not to swim.
6. SUP/paddleboarders must have buoyancy aid & leash, those without are unlikely to be members please ask them to leave the lake.

We are grateful for support and coordination from schools, Hoveringham councillor and local farmers. Local secondary schools sent out emails to all parents, which I believe reduced numbers of children attending the lake at the end of the week. It was great to see so much interest and supervised open-water swimming with Love Open Water Swimming on the small lake. Each swim contributes a fee for our club.

It was great to see so many members enjoying the heatwave on the water – lots of sailing, powerboat training, SUPing etc has been going on!

I have also been working on improving and updating **CCTV at the club**, we have coverage of a lot of area outside, in dinghy park, and in bar area of clubhouse. Also the webcam is live (following a short break!) so please be aware on the main lawn that you may be seen on the webcam.

Safety cover – please remember that duties for Wednesday evenings are for the full evening, which is casual windsurfing / wingfoiling etc. Safety teams should continue until 8:30 (as scheduled on the roster) – unless you have spoken to sailors and they are not going out. Safety teams are there to help with incidents and accidents – usually getting people to shore for first aid is the key priority. Please cooperate fully and calmly with safety team as they coordinate the response.

We had a fantastic **Hansa** training and open meeting – early in May. It was well attended, with good weather, and sailors had a great event. Thanks to all volunteers and coordinators – it's a great indicator of support as we go on to develop our Para-Pathway, with training on Sunday mornings and racing in the main series.

Finally, we have arranged for two organisations to use the lake on weekdays in term time, to bring people with disabilities or limited opportunities to come and do some water activities – this may be paddle boarding or kayaking. There are two organisations facilitating these activities: REAL education who will run their activity independently (starting in June), and Switch Up who are coordinating with training team and looking for volunteers to help on 14th July (please contact Adrian principal@ncsc.org.uk). - Neil
